Pedestrian Task Force Report

Pedestrian Task Force Chair, John LaPlante reported that the task force had met on Wednesday with 11 people in attendance, including eight technical committee members. There were several reports on pedestrian related projects and discussion of pedestrian issues coming before the NCUTCD at this meeting. The pedestrian task force has no action items to present to the Council at this time.

Markings Technical Committee Report

Markings Technical Committee chair, Gene Hawkins reported that the committee met Wednesday and Thursday with 23 members in attendance. The one Markings Committee action item was voted on by the Council yesterday and the committee has no other items to present at this time.

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RRLRT Technical Committee Report

RRLRT Technical Committee chair, Rick Campbell, reported that the committee had met Wednesday and Thursday with 31 members in attendance. They reviewed the Sponsor comments to the five items that had been sent to Sponsors and have recommendations on four of those items to present to the Council today. The Signals and RRLRT committees will continue to work on Item No. 4 on preemption and will present recommendations at the January or June meeting next year.

Moved and seconded to approve the recommendations of the RRLRT Technical Committee for changes in Section 8A08 of the MUTCD (<u>Attachment No. 1</u>). Motion passed unanimously.

Moved and seconded to approve the recommendation of the RRLRT Technical Committee for changes in Section 8A.04 of the MUTCD (<u>Attachment No. 2</u>). Motion passed unanimously.

Moved and seconded to approve the recommendation of the RRLRT Technical Committee to add new 8A.04 in the MUTCD on the use of raised center medians and Islands near grade crossings (Attachment No. 3). Motion passed with none in opposition and one abstention.

Campbell pointed out that the next recommendation had already been approved by the Council but was sent again to Sponsors and received additional comments which were considered. The revised recommendation is now being presented to the Council.

Moved and seconded to approve the recommendation of the RRLRT Technical Committee to change Section 3B.20 and add new Sections 8B.30 and 8B.31 to the MUTCD relating to Arrow and Edge Line Markings at Highway-Rail and Light Rail Transit Grade Crossings (<u>Attachment No. 4</u>). Motion passed unanimously.

RW Signs Technical Committee Report

RW Signs Technical Committee Chair, Bruce Ibarguen, reported that the committee had met Wednesday and Thursday with 22 members and four guests in attendance both days. They will have 10 new items to be sent to Sponsors. The committee presented five recommendations yesterday, four of which were approved by the Council. One was tabled and is being brought back today.

Moved and seconded to approve the recommendation of the RW Signs Technical Committee for changes to Table 2C-5, Selection of Horizontal Alignment Traffic Control Signs (<u>Attachment No.5</u>). Motion passed unanimously.

Bicycle Technical Committee Report

Bicycle Technical Committee chair, Richard Moeur, reported that the committee had met Wednesday and Thursday with a quorum present. They will have one new item to be sent to Sponsors.

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GMI Signs Technical Committee Report
