40	FHWA was aware of the revision being proposed by the RWSTC in June 2009. The
41	2009 MUTCD largely captured this proposal. Section 7B.14 of the 2003 MUTCD was
42	changed to Section 7B.15 in the 2009 MUTCD and contains the following language:
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44	Section 7B.15 School Speed Limit Assembly (S4-1P, S4-2P, S4-3P, S4-4P, S4-6P,
45	S5-1) and END SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT Sign (S5-3)
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47	Guidance:
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49	The beginning point of a reduced school speed limit zone should be at least 200 feet in
50	advance of the school grounds or a school crossing; or other school related activities;
51	however, this 200-foot distance should be increased if the reduced school speed limit is
52	30 mph or higher, <mark>but not to greater than 500 feet.</mark>
