Although this is highly desirable, there are instances where the 30 signing for similar interchanges along a route will vary due to interchange spacing and 31 other geometric features. This is variation is allowed in the Guidance section below the 32 Standard. RECOMMENDED MUTCD Provisions/Revisions: 33 34 The GMI Committee recommends the Standard section be deleted and the Guidance 35 section be revised as shown below. 36 37 Note: Proposed changes to the MUTCD are shown in underline red and removed 38 text are shown in strikethrough red. 39

## 42 Section 2E.43 Signing by Type of Interchange

- 43 Support:
- 44 01 Road users need signs to help identify the location of the exit, as
- well as to obtain route, direction, and destination information for
- specific exit ramps. Figures 2E-34 through 2E-40 show examples of
- 47 guide signs for common types of interchanges. The interchange
- 48 layouts shown in most of the figures illustrate only the major guide
- 49 signs for one direction of traffic on the freeway and on the exit ramps.
- 50 Section 2D.45 contains information regarding the signing of the
- 51 crossroad approaches and connecting roadways to freeways and
- 52 expressways.
- 53 **Standard:**
- 54 02 Interchange guide signing shall be consistent for each type
- 55 **of interchange along a route.**
- 56 Guidance:
- 57 03 02 The signing layout for all interchanges of the same type having
- 58 only one exit ramp in the direction of travel should be similar,
- 59 regardless of the interchange type. For the sake of uniform application,
- 60 the significant features of the signing plan for each of the more
- 61 frequent kinds of interchanges (illustrated in Figures 2E-34 through
- 62 2E-40) should be followed as closely as possible. Even when unusual
- 63 geometric features exist, variations in signing layout should be held to
- 64 a minimum.
