45 **Note:** TTC TC recommends retaining the wording in the 2009 Edition. Following the language
46 from the 2009 Edition is the proposed wording from the draft 2016 Edition that TTC TC
47 recommends be rejected.

49 **From the 2009 Edition:**

50 **Section 6F.02 General Characteristics of Signs**

51 Support:

52 01 TTC zone signs convey both general and specific messages by means of words, symbols, and/or arrows
53 and have the same three categories as all road user signs: regulatory, warning, and guide.

54 **Standard:**

55 02 **The colors for regulatory signs shall follow the Standards for regulatory signs in Table 2A-5 and**
56 **Chapter 2B. Warning signs in TTC zones shall have a black legend and border on an orange**
57 **background, except for the Grade Crossing Advance Warning (W10-1) sign which shall have a**
58 **black legend and border on a yellow background, and except for signs that are required or**
59 **recommended in Parts 2 or 7 to have fluorescent yellow-green backgrounds. Colors for guide signs**
60 **shall follow the Standards in Table 2A-5 and Chapter 2D, except for guide signs as otherwise**
61 **provided in Section 6F.55.**

62 Option:

63 03 Where the color orange is required, the fluorescent orange color may also be used.

64 Support:

65 04 The fluorescent version of orange provides higher conspicuity than standard orange, especially during
66 twilight.

67 Option:

68 05 Existing warning signs that are still applicable may remain in place.

69 06 In order to maintain the systematic use of yellow or fluorescent yellow-green backgrounds for
70 pedestrian,

71 bicycle, and school warning signs in a jurisdiction, the yellow or fluorescent yellow-green background for
72 pedestrian, bicycle, and school warning signs may be used in TTC zones.

73 07 Standard orange flags or flashing warning lights may be used in conjunction with signs.

74 **Standard:**

75 08 **When standard orange flags or flashing warning lights are used in conjunction with signs, they**
76 **shall not block the sign face.**

82 **Section 6F.026F.01 General Characteristics of TTC Zone Signs Standard:**

83 **The colors for regulatory signs shall follow the Standards for regulatory signs in Table 2A-5 and**
84 **Chapter 2B. except as noted in Paragraphs 4, 6, and 7 of this Section, Warning signs in TTC**
85 **zones shall have a black legend and border on an orange background, except for the Grade**
86 **Crossing Advance Warning (W10-1) sign, which shall have a black legend and border on a yellow**
