SUMMARY:

GMIreviewedthe proposed FHWA Revisions to Section 2M.10 and recommends that the proposed FHWA text addition which states that the legend of a memorial or dedication sign shall not include "ROAD" or "HIGHWAY" be deleted.

DISCUSSION

GMI believes that the proposed FHWA standard language would be controversial and conflict with existing state legislation. The first sentence of the new standard language is appropriate. However, GMI recommends that the second sentence be deleted.

Support:

Legislative bodies will occasionally adopt an actor resolution memorializing ordedicating a highway, bridge, or other component of the highway.

Guidance:

Suchmemorialordedicationnamesshouldnotappearonoralongahighway,orbeplacedonbridgesoroth erhighwaycomponents. If aroute, bridge, orhighwaycomponentis officially designated as a memorial ordedication, and if notification of the memorial ordedication is to be made on the highway right-of-

on, and if notification of the memorial or dedication is to be made on the highway right-of-way, such notification should consist of installing a memorial or dedication marker in a restarea, scenic overlook, recreational area, or other appropriate location where parking is provided with the signing inconspicuously locate drelative to vehicle operations along the highway.

Option:

If the installation of a memorial or dedication marker of fthe main road way is not practical, memorial or dedication signs may be installed on the main line. Option not needed for deviation from Guidance statement based on engineering judgment.
